Now the cooler weather is with us, the Hall Heating System has been set to winter mode. On milder days the Hall may become too hot. Please do not open windows but ask for the heating to be turned off. Most of the time Gill Johnson will be available to do this. If you are responsible for an event which takes place when Gill is not at the Hall, please see her to confirm which switch needs to be turned off. This switch is located in the office – please **do not** touch any heating controls in the basement.

If you are sitting next to a radiator and it becomes unbearably hot, most radiators have a thermostatic control that can be lowered. If you adjust this control it is **essential** that you return it to 'max' before leaving the Hall. Thank You!
