Dawn’s trip to Moldova

May I thank all those people who gave so generously when supporting me for my mission to Moldova. There was a mixture of situations, the larger towns like Chisinau were bustling with wealth and all the facilities that large towns in England have, however only 90 minutes away in Dancu there was a stark contrast.

It’s as if time had stood still. The community is dependent on charity from others as they try and support the elderly and children who live in run down bungalows with no piped water, gas, electricity and only accessible via dirt roads. Horse and carts are used as transport.

The Baptist Church tries to feed and help those that cannot support themselves and where possible creates jobs for as many as it can. We were welcomed help, continuing to renovate an old building into a garage, which when finished would create a further two jobs and the ability to maintain the old farm equipment and the vehicles that belonged to the church and wealthier people.

This community is trying to get on its feet since its independence from Russia in 1991, but for now many difficulties remain. It was a privilege to work with this community that trusts God for its provision and welcomes those as its own that come alongside to help.
