### Website Report on Andy Peddle's visit to Bromley!

'Met by Major Gillian Johnson and Lieut Colonel Steve Pallant, Andy Peddle arrived at Bromley Temple on schedule. This was part of his 7900 mile walk across the United Kingdom and Ireland, visiting Salvation Army corps and other centres. He explained his motivation for doing this to the Fifty-Plus Fellowship: "It's my way of giving thanks to God for such a good life."

Not only did he sing his theme-song: 'You'll never walk alone', but also referred to some of the heart-rending experiences of meeting homeless people en route. "When you hear their stories, you can understand just a little of why they're where they are." In referring to those who have been through one of the Army's safe-houses for victims of human trafficking, he observed: "There was such joy, such hope."

Major Gillian Johnson presented a cheque for £500 from the Bromley Corps towards the funds he is raising for the Army's work with homeless people and anti-human trafficking programmes. Major Margaret Meldrum offered a prayer for him on the remainder of his journey.'
