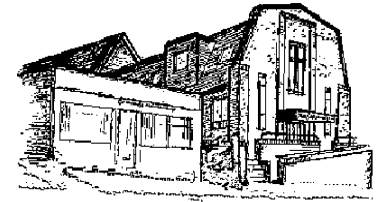

Information: A meeting was held (25 July) with regard to the proposed development of the Town Centre according to the 2008 Area Action Plan, which was waiting a Development Partner. The Council has now secured the same in Muse Development Ltd and will now be working towards a Master Plan of possible construction and development and will be consulting with local residents and businesses (and churches). This process looks like being a 30 month exercise followed, once agreed, by a 3 year building programme. More updates follow when available.
