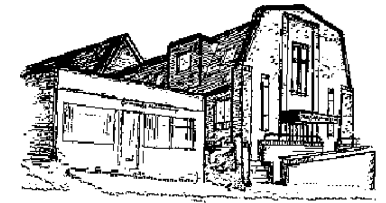

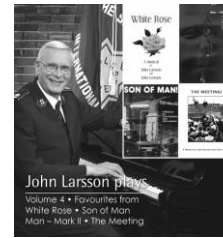
### Bromley Temple Gears Up for The Big Collection
