Corps Directory

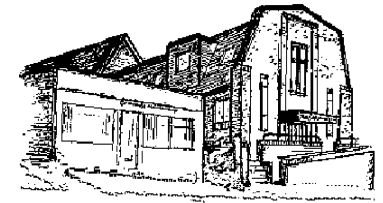
