Under the leadership of Bandmaster Geoff Nunn, the band is pleased to take responsibility for the meetings today. The morning meeting will focus on our understanding of Holy Ground with the band offering a number of meditations such as 'Love Divine', 'Green Hill' and 'How Sweet the Name' culminating with a relatively new piece of music entitled 'Shekinah'.
