event with you!



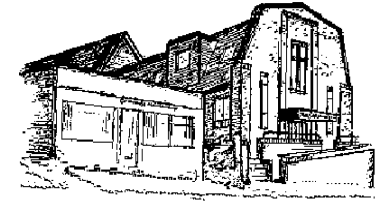

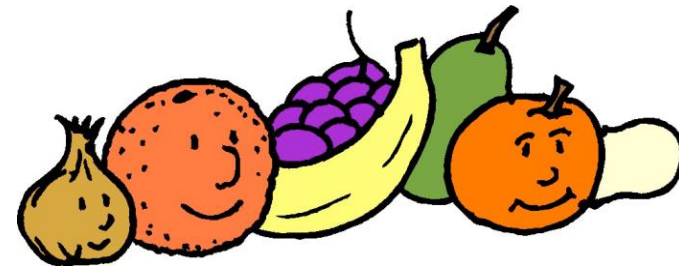
