Today is Remembrance Sunday, a day of prayer and reflection in what continues to be a troubled world. As we know, the armistice agreement which ended WW1 was signed at 11.00am on 11 November 1918. In the years following it was at this time each year that the whole nation stopped for two minutes of silent remembrance. Following the end of WW2 in 1945 the commemoration was moved to the second Sunday in November, and so we gather in remembrance once again today.

During the summer, General Shaw Clifton's book *Crown of Glory, Crown of Thorns* was published, and is a detailed account of Salvation Army work and attitudes in wartime. Having read the early chapters of his book, I felt it would be good if General Shaw could preach at our Remembrance Sunday service, and I am pleased that he was able to accept the invitation given. This morning's theme is Glory and Thorns, and our prayer is that God will come to us this morning with both challenge and blessing. The Band will be participating in the Civic Service at the Parish Church.

This evening's meeting will be Music for Remembrance Sunday, and both the Band and Songsters will be supporting. Psalm 111 will be our scripture text: a song to help us remember.

Pampered Chef


