Welcome to worship at Bromley Temple! This morning we continue thinking about the creation story under the heading of 'God's World - Our World'. We move forward from last week's thoughts around a designer cosmos, by focusing on the words STEWARDSHIP, PARTNERSHIP and RELATIONSHIP. Our text for this is Genesis 1:26 - 2:4. In this evening's meeting we will continue with our 'One Thing Prayer School' continuing where we left off last time with part 2 of session 3 - PRAYER RHYTHMS.

In many ways the two strands hold together well. The Creator wishes to have a good, growing and developing relationship with us his people. One of the ways he has given us to facilitate this, is our sense of worship and devotion which includes the life of prayer. St. Augustine once said: "'Sing to the Lord a new song,' the Psalm tells us. You sing, of course you sing... But make sure your life sings the same tune as your mouth. Sing with your voices. Sing with your hearts. Sing with your lives. Be yourselves what the words are about! If you live good lives, you yourselves are the songs of new life!"
