This makes a grand total of **£15,556.16** which is an increase of **£147.52** on last year.



We thought everyone would like to see this latest news from our Bridge Project in Georgia. Gillian Jackson writes:

"I just wanted to give you a little update that I thought you might be interested in. The Corps Council at Lagodekhi have proposed using the new shower facilities for the wider community. They wanted to offer the facility to those people who do not have hot running water in their homes. They started early October with two people using the showers at the cost of 30p to cover water and gas expenses. I thought people might be interested to know that the facilities will now be used all year round and not just for the camp"
