Welcome to Bromley Temple a fellowship of salvationists and friends who are seeking to know Jesus better, and to make Jesus better known.

Last Sunday, our meetings were led by Commissioner Norman Howe, and we thank him for his ministry here at the corps. His topic was that of preaching, in both the larger setting and the smaller, one to one context. One of his illustrations was the meeting between the prophet Nathan and King David following David's adultery with Bathsheba. This morning we pick up the story again in 2 Samuel 11 and reflect on David's behaviour and actions. Could he be forgiven for what he had done? Did God despise him as much as he despised himself? Would God forgive him? Psalm 51 helps us to feel something of David's remorse. Ephesians 3 reminds us that God's love for us in Christ goes 'wide.. long.. high and deep', and there is no depth that we can sink to that is beyond God's grasp and forgiveness.
