## **An Invitation to Prayer ...**

November 11<sup>th</sup>. 2018 marks the 100<sup>th</sup>. Anniversary of the ending of WW1.

SASRA (Soldiers' and Airmen's Scripture Reader Association) invites prayer for their work among the men of the armed services. They have designated the 100-day run-up to November 11<sup>th</sup>. (August 18<sup>th</sup> to November 11<sup>th</sup>) as a time of prayer.

You may have a link with the armed services or have an interest in them.

*'The average age of the Army is 23, and these young people face a real risk of death or injury. They need a moral compass as they make life and death decisions under immense pressure. Many of them have had no meaningful exposure to the gospel before they join up'.*

Scripture Readers are ex-servicemen usually of sergeant rank with a living experience of Christ. They wear a uniform (but without rank or privileges), and have free access within camps. They *'come alongside service personnel with a view to their spiritual welfare introducing them to a practical experience of the Christian faith as the basis of their character and morale.'*
