

## Remembrance Sunday

Just a final reminder about next Sunday.

**9.45am** A shorter morning meeting led by Alison that will conclude at 10.30am to allow for those who wish to walk up to the Market Square and join the open air service at which our band will be participating. For those unable to walk up the high street, Alison will lead a 2 minutes silence in The Light Cafe at 11am where coffee will also be served.

**6pm** Our Service of Remembrance will feature our band and songsters, readings and a photo presentation on the screen of relatives of corps members who were killed in the 1st World War (1914-1918) and 2<sup>nd</sup> World War (1939 - 1945). Bromley salvationists went to war and never returned. Salvation Army soldiers lost their lives in the bombing of Bromley in 1941. They will also be included. Your photos of your relatives need to be sent or handed to Alison or Iain by **Tuesday 6 November** for inclusion in this presentation.

We would also like to feature a display of mementos passed down from family from the World Wars. e.g. letters received from the front line, medals, photos etc. If you have any such things please pass these to Iain Alison or Gill by **Tuesday 6 November**.
